ABSTRACT Turkey hunter surveys are conducted periodically to monitor hunter and non-turkey hunter activities, attitudes toward and satisfaction with various aspects of the wild turkey management program. During this reporting period, we surveyed Pennsylvania hunters regarding their satisfaction with the fall 2019 and spring 2020 turkey seasons and to monitor changes in hunter opinions and attitudes regarding wild turkey management and regulations since the last survey in 2008 and regarding new and potentially future management and regulations. Results by question are presented in Appendix 1.

METHODS

We developed a survey instrument that was relevant to both turkey hunters and those who did not hunt turkeys to assess a wide range of opinions and attitudes towards turkey hunting and management in Pennsylvania (Appendix 1). Survey questions ranged from reasons that hunters may or may not hunt turkeys, fall and spring season structure preference, and satisfaction with various aspects of turkey hunting in Pennsylvania.

To conduct the turkey hunter survey, we used a mixed-mode approach consisting of Internet and mail response options. On 18 September 2020, we mailed a postcard to 8,467 respondents of previous Game Take Surveys

(2015–2018) and Spring Turkey Hunter Surveys (2016–2019), and a randomly drawn pool of Pennsylvania hunting license buyers. The postcard invited recipients to respond to the survey via Internet. On 25 September 2020, we mailed all recipients a reminder postcard to complete the survey via Internet. On 19 October and 23 November 2020, we mailed paper copies of the survey with postage-paid envelopes to those recipients who had not responded to the survey. Data entry closed 22 December 2020.

1. Continue to conduct periodic turkey hunter surveys to monitor hunter and non-turkey hunter activities, attitudes toward and satisfaction with various aspects of the wild turkey management program.

2020 Wild Turkey Hunter Survey Prepared by Joshua B. Johnson, Ph.D. and Mary Jo Casalena Bureau of Wildlife Management Pennsylvania Game Commission

To improve Pennsylvania Game Commission's understanding of the attitudes and opinions of Pennsylvania's turkey hunters and potential reasons limiting hunters from turkey hunting we surveyed 8,467 respondents of previous Game Take Surveys (2015–2018) and Spring Turkey Hunter Surveys (2016–2019), and a randomly drawn pool of Pennsylvania hunting license buyers. We used Dillman's tailored design survey method in conducting the survey, which included a postcard invitation to complete the survey via Internet that was mailed on 9/18/2020, a reminder postcard mailed to all survey recipients on 9/25/2020, a paper copy of the survey was mailed to nonrespondents on 10/19/2020, a final paper copy of the survey was mailed to nonrespondents on 11/23/2020, and data entry closed on 12/22/20.

We received responses from 3,315 survey recipients for a response rate of 39.7% (when adjusted for undeliverable addresses; either incorrect mailing addresses or deceased). Of those, 2,362 (71.6%) have hunted turkeys in Pennsylvania.






