


2011 Pennsylvania Waterfowl Hunter Attitudes Survey

Survey Objectives

Declining trends waterfowl hunters:	Identify reasons for and barriers to participation. Opportunities for recruiting & retaining hunters.
Determine attitudes on season timing:	Measure season timing preference by duck and goose zones.
Address other issues associated with waterfowl hunting:	Measure attitudes on issues such as electric decoys, tundra swan hunting and migratory game bird hunting stamp.

Pennsylvania HIP Canada Goose Harvest




Survey Scoping & Design

- Consulted with USFWS, PGC I & E Bureau and reviewed previous national & state surveys methods.
- Mail questionnaire of 5,000 randomly selected PA waterfowl hunters identified by the 2009-10 & 2010-11 HIP license questions through point-of-sale.
- Post-stratified survey results by residency, hunter age, gender, waterfowl hunter type (i.e. duck only, goose only, both) and hunting zone(s).
- A complete survey of attitudes on why not hunt waterfowl would include samples of non-hunters and other hunters that was beyond the scope of this survey.


PA Waterfowl Hunter demographics.

- 3,599 surveys returned for **72% response rate**.
- 88% indicated PA resident.
- 3% indicate non-resident.
- 9% did not indicate residency status.
- 97% male
- 1.5% female
- 1.5% unknown gender

Percentage of responses




Percentage of responses



Waterfowl Hunter age distribution


Average = 45.5 years old, max = 93



Waterfowl Hunter type?

- 6% or 213 respondents were only duck hunters.
- 14% or 510 were only goose hunters.
- 36% or 1,301 were both duck & goose hunters.
- 36% or 1,352 didn't hunt waterfowl the past 2 seasons.



Duck Hunter experience?

- 28% hunted greater than 25 years.
- 15% hunted between 16 and 25 years.
- 31% hunted between 6 and 15 years.
- 25% hunted ≤ 5 years.



- 25% hunted ≤ 5 years.



- 29% was very important to them.
- 23% had time to hunt.
- 18% hunt ducks when not hunting another species.
- 16% someone invited them to hunt.

- 8% there were a lot of geese this year.




- 3% Lake Erie zone.



- 3% Regulated hunting grounds.



- 86% Neither.







- 27% Both about the same.



- 78% Neither.



- 20% dissatisfied.



- 10% dissatisfied.



- 11% no opinion.



Has the quality of PA goose hunting changed?










Duck Hunter Satisfaction






Duck Hunter Satisfaction




Goose Hunter Satisfaction

- 2% don't know.


