SOUTHWEST REGION TEMPORARILY CLOSES STATE GAME LANDS 203 PARKING LOT

BOLIVAR – The Pennsylvania Game Commission’s Southwest Region Director Jason Farabaugh announced the Southwest Region will temporarily close a popular parking area on State Game Lands 203. The closure is necessary so that the construction of a new archery range near the parking lot can begin.

The parking lot to be closed is located off of Markman Park Road in Allegheny County, Marshall Township. This closure will begin on October 3, 2022 and is expected to last until the Thanksgiving Holiday. GPS coordinates for the parking lot are 40.636829, -80.126110.

State Game Lands 203 is located in Allegheny County and is a heavily used public hunting ground. It is comprised of approximately 1,208 acres and already contains one of the busiest public rifle ranges in the state. The archery range is designed to have multiple shooting stations with distances from 10 yards to 50 yards. The addition of an archery range to the area will provide outdoor enthusiasts with another opportunity to utilize this public resource.
