- SHOW DATE -

Timber will be shown to prospective bidders on **August 26, 2016**. Viewers will be met at **intersection of Quehanna Highway and Grant Trail** 10:00 a.m., and conducted to the sale area.

- BIDS -

BIDS SHOULD BE MAILED AT LEAST FOUR (4) WORKING DAYS PRIOR TO BID OPENING TO PERMIT U.S. POSTAL SERVICE DELIVERY. USE SPECIAL MAIL SERVICE IF MAILED LATER THAN FOUR DAYS PRIOR TO BID OPENING. - PERFORMANCE DEPOSIT -

A performance bond in the amount of **\$20,000.00** will be required in the form of a Certified Check or a Postal Money Order drawn to the order of the Pennsylvania Game Commission. Negotiable securities, including assignment of a bank savings account may be furnished in lieu of above. A bond with corporate surety approved by the Attorney General, or a bank Irrevocable Letter of Credit, may be posted provided the bond has an expiration date a minimum of 1 year beyond the expiration date of the timber contract.

- ANTI DISCRIMINATION -

The contractor awarded the Timber Sale Agreement agrees he will not discriminate against any employee or other persons on account of race, sex, creed, age, ancestry or national origin.

- SAFETY and ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION -

The Buyer, his employees and sub-contractors are expected to perform all logging operations in a safe manner as required by applicable laws and regulations. The Commission expects the Buyer to ensure that logging crewmembers dress in protective attire, and perform their duties with equipment in accordance with standards established by the logging industry and the Occupational Safety and Health Administration (OSHA).

The PGC recommends that logging crews working on State Game Lands be trained in safe logging techniques and sound environmental logging practices through a formal training program such as the one provided by the Pennsylvania Sustainable Forestry Initiative (PA SFI) or another similar program.

Contractor must comply with the erosion and sediment control plan for disturbed areas that is included as a part of the timber contract.

SPECIAL PROVISIONS FOR Wapiti Rendezvous

S.G.L. # 034 T.S. # 034-16-01

1) ADMINISTRATIVE ITEMS

- a) **This is a re-bid of the same sale that was bid on July 18, 2016. There are no changes in volumes or requirements.**
- b) SGL 034 Wapiti Rendezvous Sale is a 425 acre shelter-wood cut (9 acres are reserved islands/travel lanes). It contains 10 total blocks.
- c) All work must be completed in one block and approved by the Regional Forester (RF) before operations can start in another block.
- d) Whole tree harvesting is permitted for trees 12" dbh and smaller. Whole tree harvesting of all trees within areas designated as fire line breaks (100 feet width) will be permitted. All dead/snag trees within the fire line breaks must be cut, even if it is not marked with yellow paint. If the operator chooses not to use whole tree harvesting, all debris, slash, cull portions of trees must be cleared within the fire line break no less than 100 feet width.
- e) Cutting restrictions- Block 9 must be cut from July 1st to October 1st or from January 1st to March 1st.
- f) No permanent paint may be used by bidder for marking/cruising this timber sale area. Only crayons or chalk are acceptable for marking.
- g) **Payment for Block 8 (7% of the bid price) is due at contract execution. Final payment is due No Later Than 120 days before the expiration of the Agreement**

2) BOUNDARIES, BLOCKS, AND CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS

- a) All timber sale boundaries, islands, travel lanes, and block lines are marked with blue slashes and are reserved. Blue block numbers face into the blocks.
- b) **All trees marked with yellow paint must be cut.** All red maple and sweet birch between the DBH's of 2"-5" can be cut and utilized without having yellow paint on them.
- c) **All snags or hazard trees determined by the regional forester within the designated 100 ft. width fire line breaks must be felled. Any snag or hazard tree deemed to great of a safety risk to the operator may be left standing.**
- d) Trees marked with red paint in the designated landing location in block 1 are reserved.
- e) All designated landings and new haul roads are marked with orange paint and these trees are reserved.
- f) All conifers are reserved.
- g) No cutting, skidding, hauling is permitted in islands/travel lanes and herbaceous openings.
- h) No fuelwood cutting by individuals other than the operator and the operator's employees.
- i) Game Land boundary, roads, pipelines, herbaceous openings and spring runs are to be kept free of tops.

- j) All stumps must be cut lower than 12" from the ground.
- k) Cull portions of the tree are to be left at the stump. Logs and pulpwood are to be cut to length in the woods to minimize short ends at the landings.
- l) Extra caution should be taken to avoid felling damage or skidding damage to reserved trees.

3) US / STATE / LOCAL ROADS

- a) Timber will be hauled out to the Quehanna Highway from the Grant Trail. There are approximately 1.3 miles of DCNR forestry road to cross on the Grant Trail from the SGL boundary to the Quehanna Highway. There is an agreement in place between the PGC and DCNR for the use of the Grant Trail.
- b) Contractor will be responsible for all permits and bonds on both state and township roads or any other road not owned by the PGC.

4) GAME LAND ROADS TO BUILD / IMPROVE

a) **Road to Build**

1. Segments are identified on the road work map, and are located in Block 7 and access into block 10.
2. The new roads are both approximately 600 feet long and are to have a running surface of 12 feet. The contractor must first cut all trees within 45 feet width and remove all stumps necessary to construct the road. Both roads will be required to be seeded at the conclusion of their use for this sale. See section 7 for seed mixture requirements.

b) **Road to Improve**

1. Refer to the attached road work map and road work descriptions (section 5) for material placement locations and amounts for the roads to improve for this sale. A minimum of 3100 tons of stone sub-base fill will be required for road work. **Stone specifications and new culvert quantities are for minimum road requirement only. The Regional Forester may require more culverts, stone, or road work at any time due to various factors such as weather condition, new haul road construction, landing locations, and operator's care during logging operations.**

Total Stone Sub-base Needed: 3100 tons Minimum

2. There are two stone pits located within 1.5 miles of the sale. They are located on the Moshannon State Forest and have been approved for use of this sale. They must be reclaimed/leveled after conclusion of their use and will require to be seeded (see Section 7 for rates and seed mixtures). Any operation on the Moshannon State Forest will be at the discretion of the RF. If suitable stone sub-base is not found at either of the two designated stone pits, the operator will supply their own stone from an off-site location.
3. The operator must use a bulldozer with 6 way blade or road grader to shape and grade the roadway as stone is applied. Operator must also roll with a vibrating roller as stone is being applied. Roller is ten ton minium.
4. At the conclusion of road use, the culverts are to have catch basins and tail ditches cleaned out with a backhoe or excavator.

5. At the conclusion of road use, all roads will be properly graded. Ditches and other drainage structures must be opened or re-established where needed. The roads must also be crowned to drain water into the ditches and culverts. Additional stone may be required by the RF during this time.
6. **The Grant Trail and Barr Hollow Trail are both roads opened all year to the public and must remain open and drivable at all times.**
7. The contractor will also seed, lime, and fertilize all roads not receiving stone and (see Section 7 for rates and seed mixtures).

c) **Culverts**

1. Culverts info. The operator must install smooth bore, double-walled plastic culverts with a backhoe or excavator. These culverts must meet Penn Dot specifications for use on public roads. Culverts must have adequate catch basins and tail ditches installed. Culverts needed for these roads are as follows:

Ten (10) – 18” diameter by 30’ length

2. The new culverts must be set in a minimum of 4” of 2A gravel and covered with an additional 1’ of 2A gravel. This will require 20 tons of 2A gravel for each installation. **A total of 200 tons of 2A gravel will be required for the culvert installations.** This gravel is not available on the gameland. It must be purchased off-site and delivered to the gameland. All culvert installation locations are marked on the attached road work map and will be specified on location by the RF.

Total 2A Gravel Needed: 200 Tons

5) DETAILED ROAD WORK DESCRIPTION

- a) **A to B:** Approximately 1.3 miles of Grant Trail on the Moshannon State Forest.
Treatment: Spot treatment as needed per request of the Regional Forester
- b) **B to C:** Approximately 1500 feet of Grant Trail on State Game Land.
Treatment: 3 inches of sub-base fill. One culvert required.
- c) **C to D:** Approximately 1200 feet of Barr Hollow Trail on State Game Land.
Treatment: 3 inches of sub-base fill. Pipeline crossing will require 3 feet of sub-base fill.
- d) **D to E:** Approximately 1000 feet of Barr Hollow Trail on State Game Land.
Treatment: 10 inches of sub-base fill. Two culverts required.
- e) **E to F:** Approximately 1500 feet of Barr Hollow Trail on State Game Land.
Treatment: 3 inches of sub-base fill. One culvert required.
- f) **F to G:** Approximately 300 feet of Barr Hollow Trail on State Game Land.
Treatment: 10 inches of sub-base fill. One culvert required.
- g) **G to H:** Approximately 1600 feet of Barr Hollow Trail on State Game Land.
Treatment: Spot treatment of 3 inches of sub-base fill as per request of the Regional Forester. One temporary culvert required to access the landing in block 8.
- h) **H to Borrow Pit 1:** Approximately 500 feet of Barr Hollow Trail on the Moshannon State Forest.
Treatment: Spot treatment as needed per request of the Regional Forester.

- i) **E to Gate:** Approximately 500 feet of State Game Land road.
Treatment: 3 inches of sub-base fill. One culvert required.
- j) **Gate to I:** Approximately 1500 feet of State Game Land road.
Treatment: Spot treatment as needed per request of the Regional Forester.
- k) **I to K:** Approximately 600 feet of proposed haul road construction.
Treatment: Stumps need to be removed, leveled, and spot treatment as needed per request of the Regional Forester.
- l) **I to J:** Approximately 1000 feet of State Game Land road.
Treatment: Spot treatment as needed per request of the Regional Forester.
- m) **C to L:** Approximately 2100 feet of Grant Trail on State Game Land.
Treatment: 3 inches of sub-base fill. Three culverts are required. A portion (100ft by 100ft) of the landing in block 5 will require 6 inches of sub-base topped with 2" of 2B limestone.
- n) **L to M:** Approximately 1200 feet of Grant Trail on State Game Land.
Treatment: 3 inches of sub-base fill.
- o) **M to N:** Approximately 600 feet of proposed haul road construction.
Treatment: Stumps need to be removed, leveled, and spot treatment as needed per request of the Regional Forester.
- p) **M to O:** Approximately 1200 feet of Grant trail on State Game Land.
Treatment: Spot treatment as needed per request of the Regional Forester

Please note that these stone specifications are estimates and are for minimum road requirements only. Stone depths are averages for the segment lengths. Stone requirements could be considerably more depending on hauling, weather conditions, and new road construction.

6) **LANDINGS**

- a) All landings are to be approved by the Regional Forester. Main landings locations are designated on the sale map.
- b) There are seven new landings to be constructed in blocks 1, 4, 5, 7, 8, 9, and 10.
- c) The landings in blocks 1, 7, and 10 will be turned into herbaceous openings at the close of their use and will require no stone sub-base. All stumps will be removed from these landings.
- d) The landing in block 5 will require 100ft by 100ft of stone placed 6" in depth for sub-base. Eighty (80) tons of 2A limestone will be required on top of the sub-base spread at an approximate depth of 2 inches.
2A Limestone Needed: 80 Tons

- e) All other landings will be chosen by the operator and approved by the RF. The herbaceous openings CANNOT be used for landing, skidding, or hauling.
- f) Road side landing along the Grant Trail and Barr Hollow Trail will be permitted at locations approved by the RF. Both roads are open all year to the public and must remain open and drivable at all times
- g) Logging debris is to be kept to a minimum. All logs and pulpwood are to be marked to length in the woods to minimize short ends at the landings.
- h) At the conclusion of the sale, all landings are to be leveled, cleared of debris, and seeded according to specifications outlined in Section 7 below.

7) **SKIDDING**

- a) Skid trails will be designated by the Regional Forester. Existing trails are to be used for skidding and must be left open and level.
- b) Haul road crossing and skidding will be required across one right-of-way gas pipeline. The pipeline is owned by EQT Production. The operator will be responsible to contact EQT's Pipeline Operator, Jason Clark (724-255-2481) and have an on-site meeting to acquire specifications and requirements for road crossing and skidding on the gas pipeline.**
- c) No skidding across small drainages will be permitted without the use of temporary bridges.
- d) Skidders are to be kept off of haul roads as much as possible.
- e) Wet areas should be avoided when skidding and any treetops which are felled into small wet areas should be left in the water rather than pulled out.
- f) Skidding on herbaceous openings is not permitted.
- g) If skid trails are to sit idle for one month or more they are to have water bars added.
- h) Main skid trails are to be leveled, open and have water bars added at the conclusion of the sale.

8) **SEEDING OF ROADWAYS AND LANDINGS**

- a) At the conclusion of the sale, landings, stone pits, newly constructed haul roads, and disturbed areas along gamelands roads are to be leveled, cleared of rocks and debris and seeded according to the following:

5 lbs. /acre of LADINO or WHITE CLOVER - Inoculated Seed
 6 lbs. /acre of CRIMSON CLOVER - Inoculated Seed
 50 lbs. /acre of OATS (spring) or WHEAT (fall)

Lime 2 tons per acre of pulverized agricultural limestone
 Fertilizer - 300 lbs. per acre of 10-20-20

Note: These are per acre rates. Total acres disturbed through logging will be determined at conclusion of the sale. Area should not exceed 7 acres. If additional roads and landings are constructed more acres of seeding will be necessary as per request of the Regional Forester.

- b) Straw mulch will be required at a rate of 2.5 tons per acre or 100 bales per acre.

- c) The Regional Forester is to be notified prior to the application of lime, seed, fertilizer, and mulch.
- d) All other bulldozed skid trails are to be seeded with wheat.
- e) Guaranteed catch of cover must be obtained to the satisfaction of the Regional Forester before the bond will be released.

9) **OPERATIONS AND NON-WORK DAYS**

- a) No woods operation will be permitted on the following days:
 - 1. All Saturdays in the months of October, November, December, and January.
 - 2. The opening day and all Saturdays during spring turkey season, including the youth spring gobbler hunt.
 - 3. All the days of the general statewide bear season
 - 4. The entire 2 weeks of the general firearms deer season
 - 5. The opening day of the flintlock muzzleloader season

No woods operation will be permitted from **March 1st thru April, 15th without** the permission of the Regional Forester.

- b) The contractor, employees, and sub-contractors may not hunt to, from, or at the job site when the work location is beyond a gated road that is closed to public traffic. The contractor may travel to and from the work location on no-work days to check on the condition of equipment.
- c) ***Except on Sundays, it is unlawful to be present on State Game Lands from November 15 through December 15 inclusive when not engaged in lawful hunting or trapping and fail to wear a minimum of 250 square inches of daylight fluorescent-orange material on the head, chest, and back combined, or in lieu thereof, a hat of the same colored material. The material shall be worn so it is visible in a 360-degree arc.***

10) **MISCELLANEOUS**

- a) Operator must comply with the erosion and sedimentation control plan for the area.
- b) Operator is to use gated game land roads for logging purposes only. There is one gated road on this sale. It will be required to be kept closed and locked when the operator is not working. Operator must supply a lock for the gate.
- c) Operator will supply all employees working on this sale with a copy of the map and provisions.
- d) **Successful bidder is to contact PA One Call (1-800-242-1776) prior to construction of landings, haul roads, skid trails, or other earth moving activity to identify and locate underground utility lines.**
- e) *Violation of contract provisions by the operator may subject the operator or its employees or contractors to fine based on Title 58 regulations.*

11) **SAFETY AND LOGGER TRAINING**

The Buyer, his employees and sub-contractors are expected to perform all logging operations in a safe manner as required by applicable laws and regulations. The Commission expects the Buyer to ensure that logging crewmembers dress in protective attire, and perform their duties with

equipment, in accordance with standards established by the logging industry and the Occupational Safety and Health Administration (OSHA).

The PGC recommends that logging crews working on State Game Lands be trained in safe logging techniques and sound environmental logging practices through a formal training program such as the one provided by the Pennsylvania Sustainable Forestry Initiative or another similar course.

12) PA RIGHT TO KNOW PROVISIONS

CONTRACT PROVISIONS – RIGHT TO KNOW LAW

- a. The Pennsylvania Right-to-Know Law, 65 P.S. §§ 67.101-3104, applies to this contract.
- b. Unless the Contractor provides the Commonwealth, in writing, with the name and contact information of another person, the agency shall notify the Contractor using the Contractor information provided by the Contractor in SRM [or “the legal contact information provided in this contract”] if the agency needs the Contractor’s assistance in any matter arising out of the Right to Know Law (“RTKL”). The Contractor shall notify the agency in writing of any change in the name or the contact information within a reasonable time prior to the change.
- c. Upon notification from the Commonwealth that the Commonwealth requires the Contractor’s assistance in responding to a RTKL request for records in the Contractor’s possession, the Contractor shall provide the Commonwealth, within fourteen (14) calendar days after receipt of such notification, access to, and copies of, any document or information in the Contractor’s possession which arises out of the contract that the Commonwealth requests (“Requested Information”) and provided such other assistance as the Commonwealth may request in order to comply with the RTKL. If the Contractor fails to provide the Requested Information within fourteen (14) calendar days after receipt of such request, the Contractor shall indemnify and hold the Commonwealth harmless for any damages, penalties, detriment or harm that the Commonwealth may incur as a result of the Contractor’s failure, including any statutory damages assessed against the Commonwealth.
- d. The Commonwealth’s determination as to whether the Requested Information is a public record is dispositive of the question as between the parties. Contractor agrees not to challenge the Commonwealth’s decision to deem the Requested Information a Public Record. If the Contractor considers the Requested Information to include a request for a Trade Secret or Confidential Proprietary Information, as those terms are defined by the RTKL, the Contractor will immediately notify the Commonwealth, and will provide a written statement signed by a representative of the Contractor explaining why the requested material is exempt from public disclosure under the RTKL within seven (7) calendar days of receiving the request. If, upon review of the Contractor’s written statement, the Commonwealth still decides to provide the Requested Information, Contractor will not challenge or in any way hold the Commonwealth liable for such a decision.
- e. The Commonwealth will reimburse the Contractor for any costs associated with complying with this provision only to the extent allowed under the fee schedule established by the Office of Open Records or as otherwise provided by the RTKL if the fee schedule is inapplicable.
- f. Contractor agrees to abide by any decision to release a record to the public made by the Office of Open Records, or by the Pennsylvania Courts. The Contractor agrees to waive all rights or remedies that may be available to it as a result of the Commonwealth’s disclosure of Requested Information pursuant to the RTKL. Contractor’s duties relating to the RTKL are continuing duties that survive the expiration of this contract and shall continue as long as the Contractor has Requested Information in its possession.




