Antlers versus Horns	
Antlers	Horns
Grow on members of the Cervidae family	Grow on member of the Bovidae family:
Fast growing	Slow growing
Shed annually	Permanent
Made of solid bone	Made of a bony core covered in thin layer of keratin
Grown only by males (except caribou)	Grown by both males and females
Cannot tell the age of the animal by looking	Can tell the age by looking at growth rings

Often branched	Often not branched
Grow from the tip	Grow from the base
