## Paper Plate Snow Goose craft

Today we will be making a Snow Goose out of a paper plate!

Step 1: Make sure you have all the supplies. You will need:

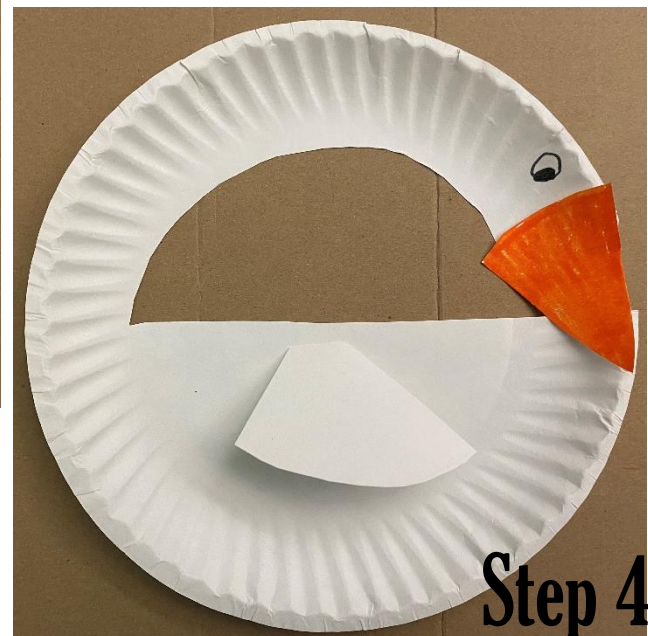
- Paper plate
- Scissors
- Orange and Black markers
- Glue stick

Step 2: Start by making a cut about halfway down the paper plate. Cut all the way across the paper plate, stopping just before the ribbed edge. Then, cut back along the ribbed edge so you cut out a half-moon shape. Save this half-moon piece, we will need it later!

Step 3: Cut the half-moon piece in thirds, so you're left with rounded triangles. Take one rounded triangle and fold the tip over. Glue this to the middle of what's left of the paper plate. This is your goose's wing!

Step 4: Take another rounded triangle and cut off the rounded bottom. You should now have a straight triangle. Color this orange, and glue to

the curved part at the top of the paper plate. This is your goose's beak!  
Take the black marker and give your goose an eyeball. Your Snow goose  
is complete! Hang him/her proudly on your wall.
